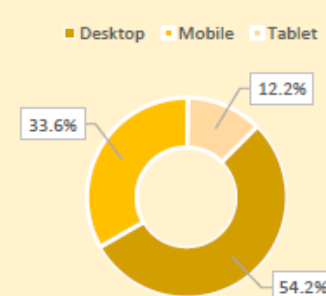

device types breakdown



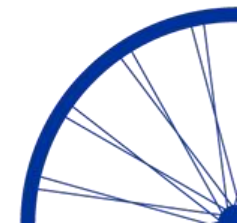

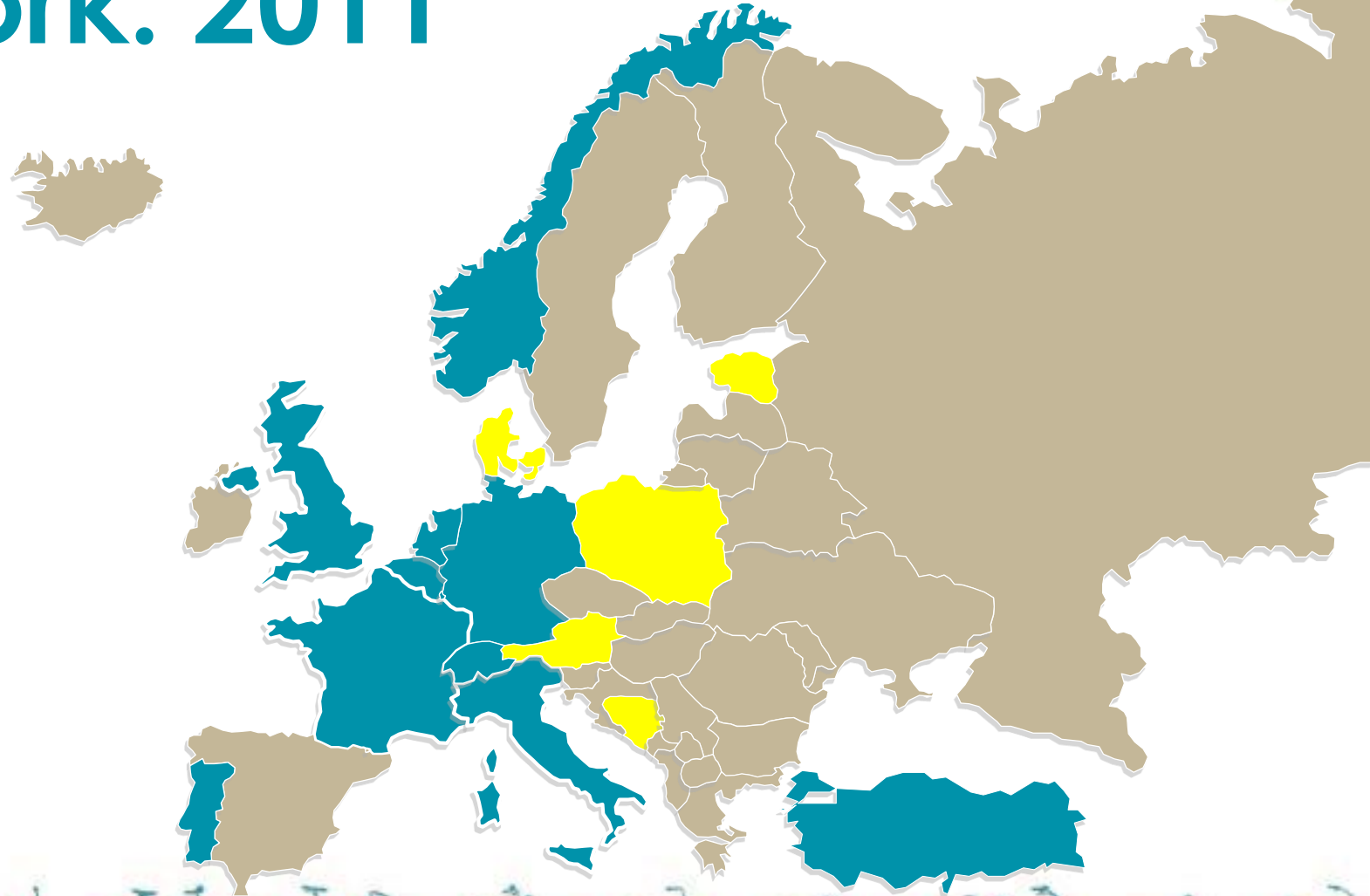




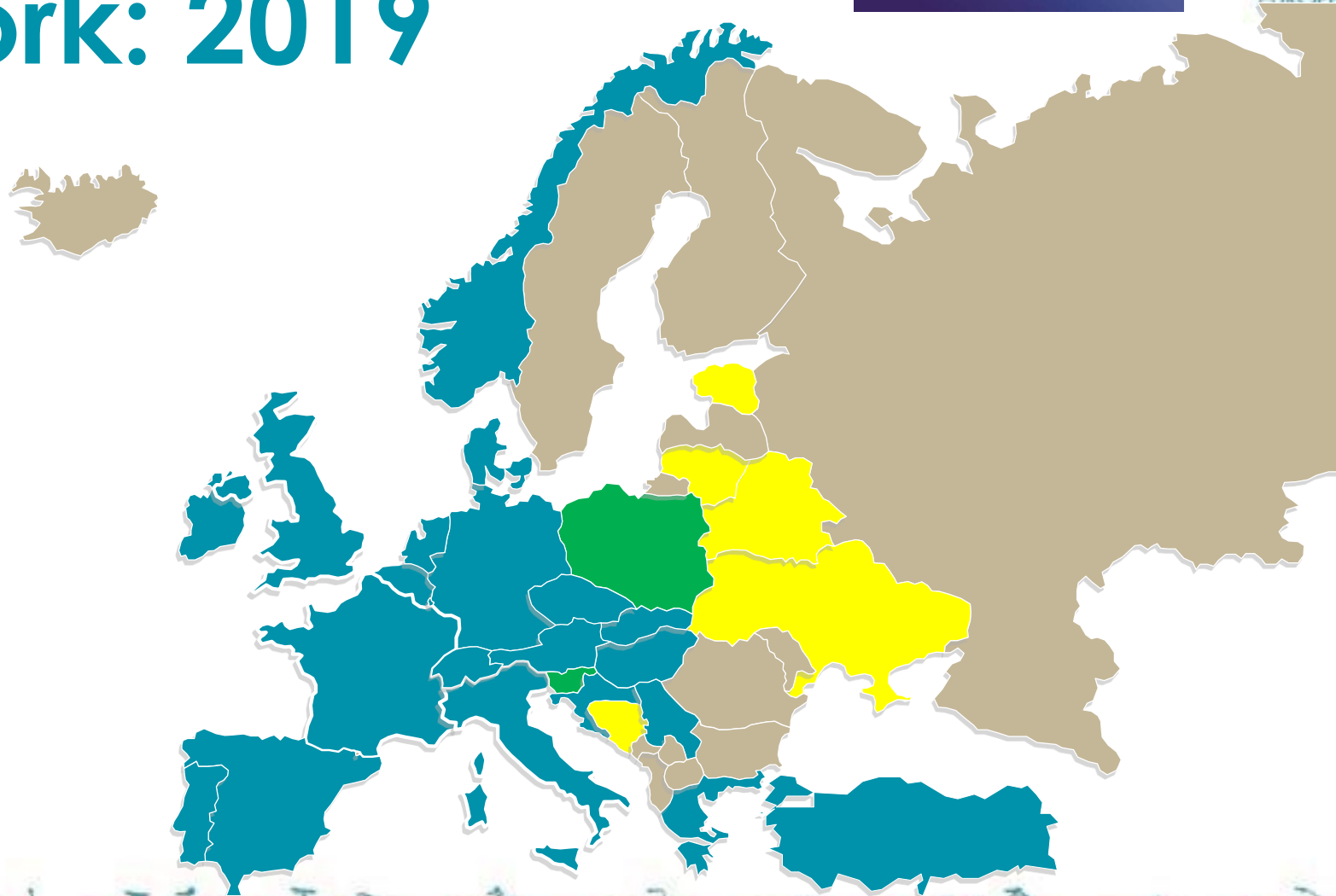
Consolidated NECC/Cs Network



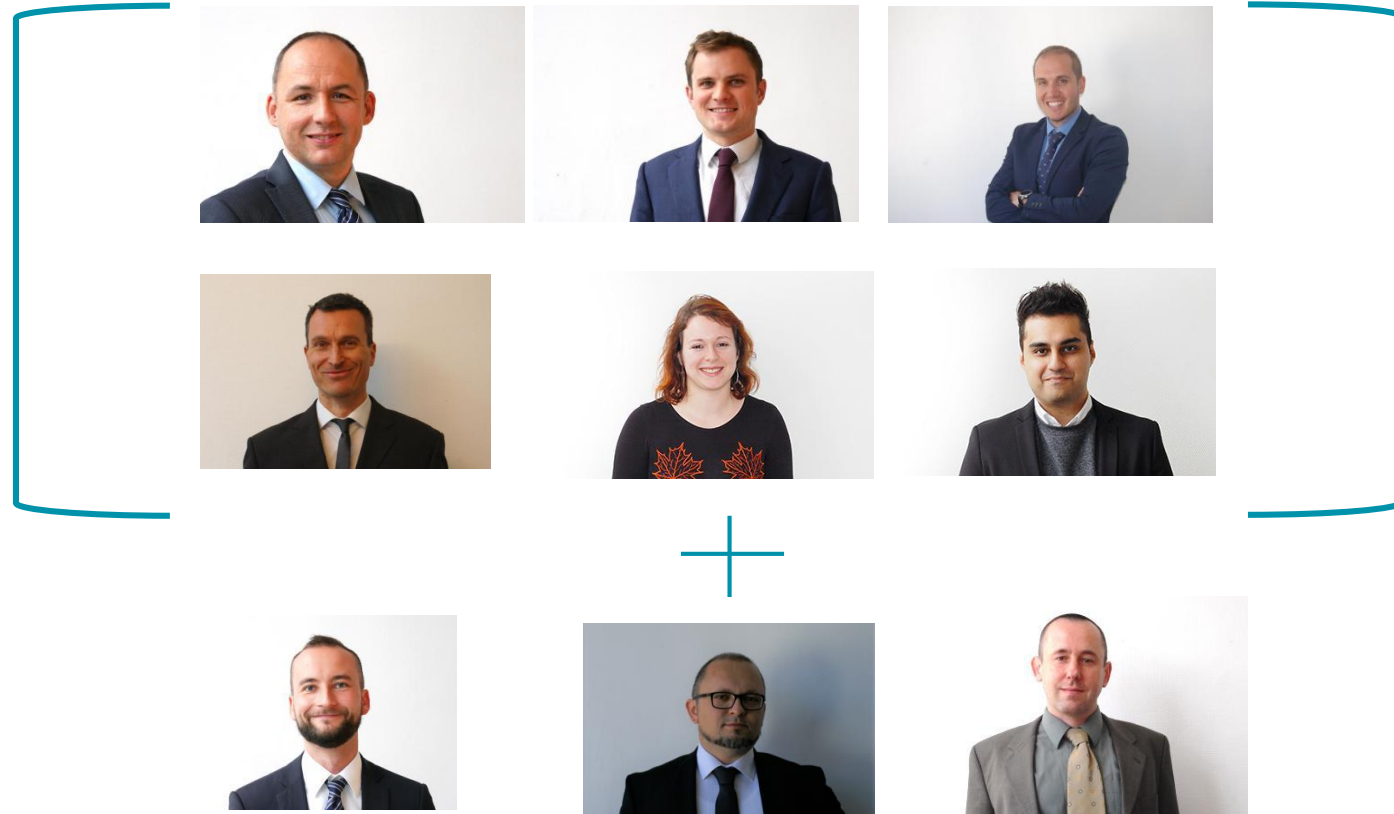
EuroVelo NECC/Cs Network: 2011
