### Objectives, background

- ECF objective, to complete the EuroVelo Network by 2020. In addition, we work hard to encourage continued quality improvement on the routes.
- ECF imposes stringent quality criteria on the proposers of new routes and it is therefore right that existing routes should be under pressure to proceed at a similar level.



### Objectives, background

- However, there are some routes
   / major sections where little or no
   progress can be measured. We
   would like to give them an
   additional boost to speed up the
   development.
- The lack of progress along certain routes could undermine the value of the EuroVelo brand.



### Types of actions

The approval of the ECF is required for the following actions:

- AR: Add new route (with new number) to the EuroVelo network
- DR: Cancel / delete an existing numbered route from the EuroVelo network
- AS: Add a new major section / extension to an existing route
- DS: Cancel / D\delete a major section of an existing route
- MC: Major change to an existing route (alter the itinerary of the route)
- CN: Change the number of an existing route

### Costs

#### Costs – of development:

Depends on the current status of the route. At least additional signalization (EV panels) are needed approx. 10-50 Euro/km.

#### Costs - the fee for ECF:

New route proposal €10,000 + 0.5 Euro / km.

Significant / major change €5,000 + 0.5 Euro / km.

The fees should be paid in 3 equal instalments corresponding to stages: III, IV and VI 06879444

### Challenges

- Some new route ideas are not prepared, mature enough – postpone them for the next round.
- Some shorter (good)
  route proposals didn't
  reach the minimum
  length (1000km) try to
  enlarge merge them
- Nobody applied to delete a major route or section
  - ECF took the initiative
  - call for actions



We identified those routes and major sections where:

- The ECF has never received or there is no publically available clear, precise itinerary (at a scale of 1:100.000 scale at least). OR
- We cannot provide a deep link to at least basic information about the route on the internet on EuroVelo.com. AND
- We did not receive any news or information about any running development projects of these routes or major sections.

#### Next steps:

- The ECF will publish this information on EuroVelo.org as a warning list and send an official email to the affected NECC/Cs and the relevant stakeholders.
  - What is the situation regarding that section / route? Send us the latest available itinerary and website (where we can find at least the basic information).
  - What is planned to complete that section / route by 2020? Do you think it will be realised by 2020?
  - If you think it will not be or cannot be realised by 2020, do you propose to delete that section fully or partly or make another significant change (move or merge with another route)?

#### Next steps:

- Make decisions at the first EuroVelo Council meeting in 2016 :
  - Delete those routes or sections which do not have at least a defined itinerary by the end of 2015. In case of deleting major sections the remaining route sections should be continuous.
  - Approve merging routes where they are requested by the relevant NECC/Cs and stakeholders.
  - Keep under surveillance until the end of 2018 those routes or sections which do not have at least a national website and projects or developments planned to have at least signalisation ready by the end of 2018. These are classified as "under-performing routes".

#### Next steps:

At the first EuroVelo Council meeting in 2019.
 Consider each of the under-performing routes routes
 / sections and reach a decision on how to treat it (i.e.
 to keep in the network, delete or merge).
