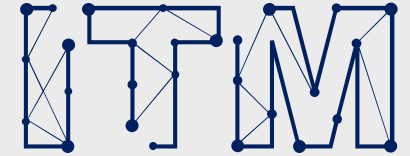
EuroVelo routes - overview





- Application submitted to ECF in 2018
- NECC consortium of 3 organizations
 - Ministry for Innovation and Technology, Cycling Coordination Department
 - Hungarian Cycling Tourism Association (NGO)
 - Hungarian Tourism Agency (gov. agency)
- Main activities:
 - Route and signing coordination
 - Communication, promotion, networking and lobbying
 - Reporting, monitoring
 - Network of cycling friendly services, PT connections

EuroVelo 6 – Atlantic – Black Sea



470 km in Hungary, along the Danube.

Popular route among domestic and international tourists

Signalized and partly constructed

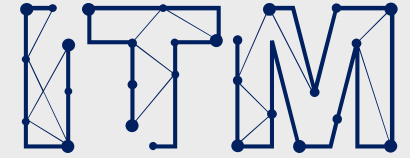
Section between Rajka and Budapest will be reconstructed by 2020

EuroVelo 6 – Atlantic – Black Sea

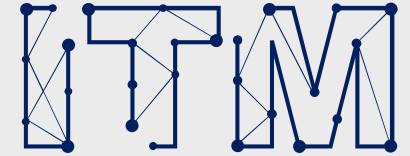


Ongoing developments:

- Construction of Budapest – Szentendre section
- New bridges on Danube 2020/2021
- Planning and design is several sections / construction in 2020/2021



EuroVelo 11 – East Europe



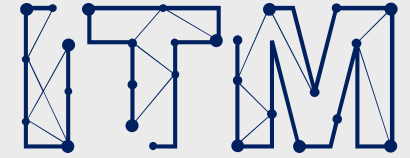
440 km in Hungary, along River Bodrog and Tisza.

Dams, low traffic roads, cycle path

Several sections are signposted but signs do not comply with ECF standards



EuroVelo 11 – East Europe

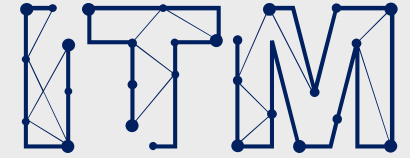


Ongoing developments:

- New sections around Tokaj
- Improvement of services around Lake Tisza

Mostly under development

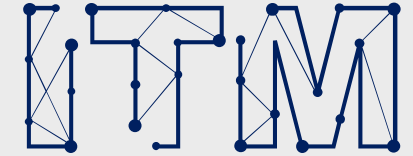
Austrian-Hungarian border section is fully signposted

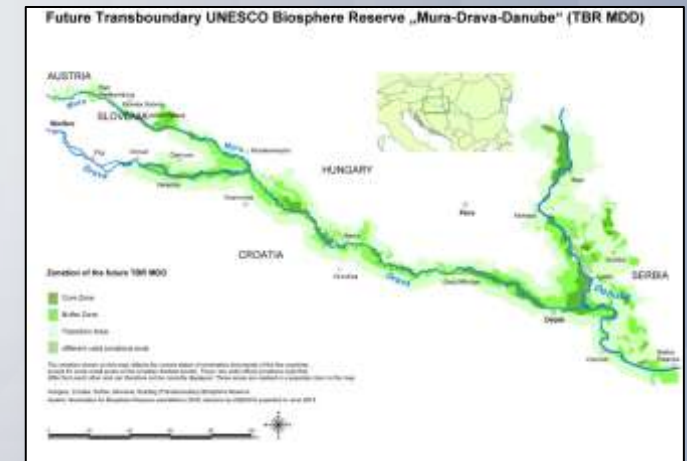


EuroVelo 13 – Iron Curtain trail

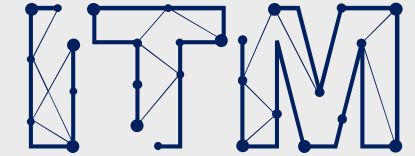


Ongoing developments:

 - Training, promotion
- INTERREG Danube Transnational Programme project – Amazon of Europe – Sustainable Cycling Tourism (3,0 million EUR)
 - Brand, bookable products
 - Visitor Guidance, promotion
 - Bike trail and resting areas



EuroVelo 14 – Waters of Central Europe

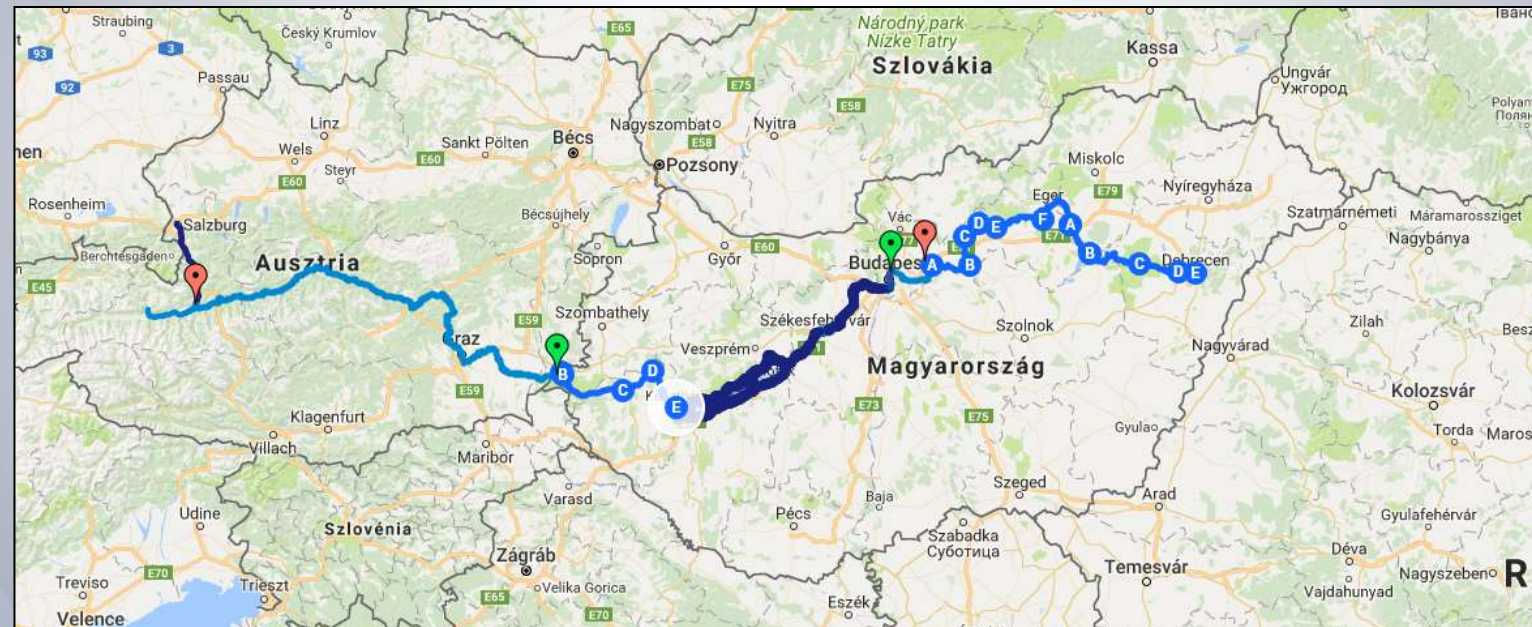


Application in 2017

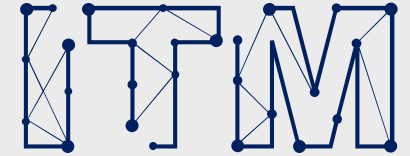
695 km in Hungary

AT partners: Radlobby, Styria, Burgenland, Salzburg (Phase I), Vorarlberg, Tirol (Phase II)

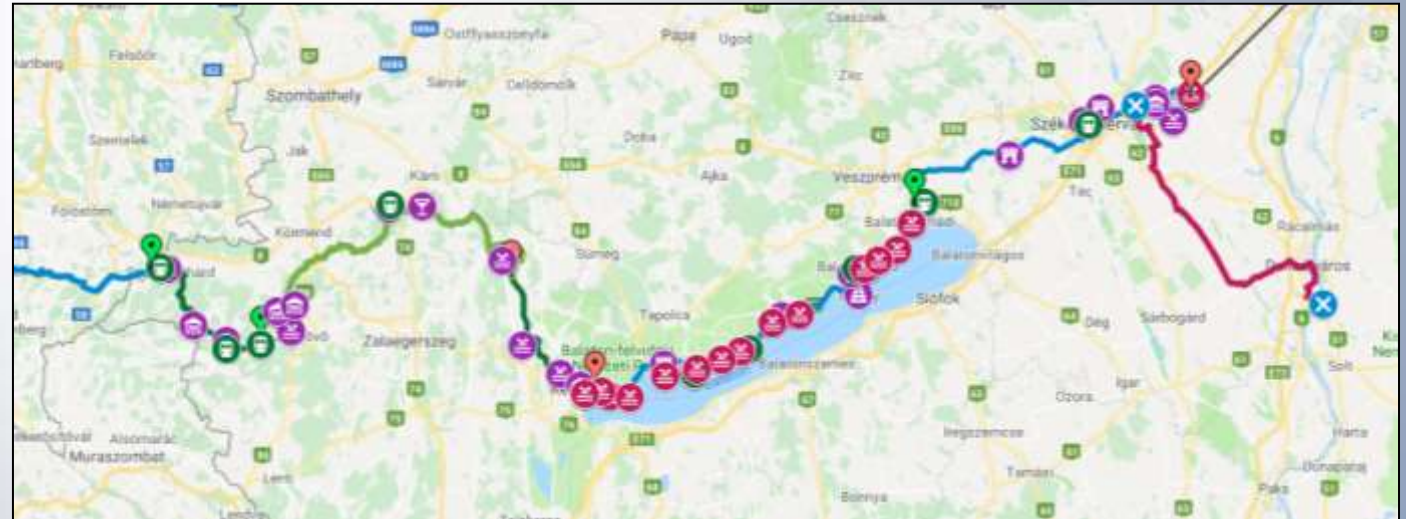


EuroVelo 14 – Waters of Central Europe
